### 4. First Aid Measures

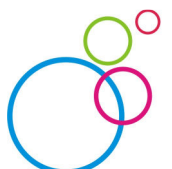
Inhallation: Remove from exposure site to fresh air. Keep at rest. Obtain medical attention.

Eye Exposure: Rinse immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 mins. Contact a doctor if symptoms persist.

## 5. Fire Fighting Measures

Extinguishing Media Recommended:	Use CO <sub>2</sub> , Dry Powder or Foam Extinguishers, spraying extinguishing media to base of flames. Do not use direct water jet on burning material.
Special Measures:	Avoid vapour inhalation. Keep away from sources of ignition. Do not smoke. Wear positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus & protective clothing.
Extinguishing Procedures:	Closed containers may build up pressure when exposed to heat and should be cooled with water spray.

## 6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal precautions:	Avoid inhalation & direct contact with skin & eyes. Use individual protective equipment (safety glasses, waterproof-boots, suitable protective clothing) in case of major spillages..
Environmental precautions: Cleaning up methods for spillages:	Keep away from drains, soils, surface & ground waters. Remove all potential ignition sources. Contain spilled material. Cover with an inert or non-combustible inorganic absorbent material, sweep up and remove to an approved disposal container. Observe local disposal regulations.

## 7. Handling and Storage

Precautions in handling:	Apply good manufacturing and industrial hygiene practices ensuring proper ventilation. Do not drink, eat or smoke while handling. Observe good personal hygiene.
Storage conditions:	Store in tightly closed original container, in a cool, dry & ventilated area away from heat sources & protected from light. Keep air contact to a minimum.
Fire protection:	Keep away from ignition sources and naked flame. Take precautions to avoid static discharges in working area.

Respiratory protection:	Avoid breathing product vapour. Apply local ventilation where possible.
Ventilation:	Ensure good ventilation of working area.

Opdyke (1975) found Cornmint oil to be non-irritant, non-sensitising and non-phototoxic (see *FCT*, **13**, 771 Special Issue II (Binder p258). LD<sub>50</sub> acute oral: 1.24g/Kg. Cornmint oil is, however, thought to be more toxic than oil from *Mentha piperita*, from the higher pulegone content.

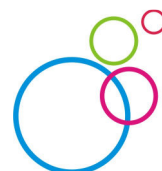
